

- Submit the completed application and one original letter of recommendation provided by school personnel (Teacher, Counselor or principal) to Columbus Electric Coop by 5 p.m. on Friday, December 13, 2019.
- If selected, the delegate will need to attend a personal interview with a parent/guardian at the Columbus Electric Coop office in Deming or Animas.

Dates of importance

- Friday, December 13, 2019: Must return application and all materials to CEC.
- Friday, February 7, 2020: Student will be notified that he or she has been chosen.
- ◆ Monday, February 10, 2020: If selected, student and parent/guardian will need to complete application and review rules and code of conduct. This will be scheduled and will be held at the Deming or Animas office.

Selection Process
