Rebate Requirements

Must provide proof of purchase (<u>itemized receipt or invoice</u>) for motor or specification sheet indicating horsepower of the motor. Receipt(s) must be legible and clearly show detailed product make and model information.

- ✓ Motors must be **new** and a minimum of 10 horsepower.
- ✓ For VSD retrofit- if a new motor is installed at the same time, it may qualify for a separate motor rebate.
- ✓ Replacement of existing VSD's, for maintenance or other purposes does not qualify.
- ✓ For VSD retrofit- soft start kits added to existing motors are not eligible for rebate
