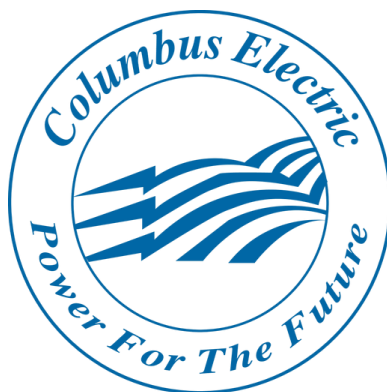

Application Overview

Application Requirements:

- ✓ Currently be in the 10th, 11th or 12th grade when submitting an application.
- ✓ Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ✓ Be an immediate family member of an active CEC member.
- ✓ Be able to participate in the Youth Tour in Washington, D.C on June 17-24, 2024
- ✓ If selected, the student must attend a personal interview with a parent/guardian at a CEC office.
- ✓ If selected, the student and parent/guardian will be required to complete a national application and review rules and code of conduct for the Youth Tour.

Selection Process

The selection committee appointed by the foundation board will review all completed applications blindly; all names, addresses, and any identifying information will be concealed.
