- ✓ Be able to participate in the Youth Tour in Washington, D.C on June 13-18, 2023
- ✓ If selected, the student must attend a personal interview with a parent/guardian at a CEC office.
- ✓ If selected, the student and parent/guardian will be required to complete a national application and review rules and code of conduct for the Youth Tour.
